Third Well Project

> AES Northeast Engineering – Shannon Vogt

Shannon provided the Village Board of Trustees with an update on the Third Well Drilling Project. Layne, the drilling company has reached a depth of 85' with the 24' drill casing. They have hit a large boulder and are moving to the 20' drill casing. Layne had to bring several additional pieces of equipment to the site to assist in getting through this boulder.

This will have an impact on the proposed timeline for this section of the project. It was originally planned to take five months to drill and complete testing on the test well. It is now being projected that this will take seven months. As a result, AES Northeast Engineering's contract will need to be amended to account for the additional project oversight the time extension will take. Three cost estimates were provided to the Board for consideration.

The Village Board discussed the options, their concerns, and the future plans for additional issues the project could face.

VILLAGE OF MALONE RESOLUTION NO. 176-2023

COMMEMORATING THE 110TH ANNIVERSARY OF MALONE LODGE OF ELKS NO. 1303

WHEREAS, The Malone Lodge of Elks No. 1303 was instituted on May 29, 1913, after more than a year of organizational efforts made by Elks living in and around the Malone community, spearheaded by Jack Flanagan who called a meeting held in Putnam's Opera Hall in Malone, New York, for area residents to discuss the organization of the Lodge, from which the group named F. Roy Kirk to assume leadership of the initiative, who was officiated on February 24, 1912; and

WHEREAS, after the first petition of dispensation signed by 97 men throughout Franklin County failed to be approved, F. Roy Kirk finalized a second petition that was given approval and Grand Exalted Ruler Mills granted a charter; this successful petition held 40 signatures from the Malone area and 37 of those signers appeared for the initiation at the institutional proceedings on May 29, 1913, where the group gained the distinction of being listed as charter members of Malone Lodge No. 1303 Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks; and

WHEREAS, in its humble beginnings, the Malone Lodge No. 1303 held their meetings in a myriad of locations before actions were taken to purchase their permanent residence at the Sidney J. Robinson property on Elm Street on November 14, 1913; the residence is regarded as one of the most significant historical sites in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Ladies 1303 Club, affiliated with the Malone Lodge, was organized on December 15, 1960 and it serves as an integral part of the Lodge today; in 1995, the Elks National Convention voted to grant women full membership in the Lodge; and

WHEREAS, the Benevolent and Protective Order of the Elks is built on the principles of charity, justice, brotherly love, and fidelity; the mission statement of the Lodge aims to promote the welfare and enhance the happiness of its members, to quicken the spirit of American patriotism, to cultivate good fellowship, and to serve the people and communities they support through various charitable works; and

WHEREAS, the success of the Malone Lodge of Elks No. 1303 is in direct correlation to the efforts of its members, whose involvement is, and always has been, characterized by an impressive commitment, an unbridled enthusiasm, and an uncompromising standard of excellence in all endeavors on behalf of the organization and the community it serves;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED, That I, Village of Malone Mayor Andrea M. Dumas, commemorate the 110th Anniversary of Malone Lodge of Elks No. 1303, and to commend its members, past and present, who have labored so conscientiously to secure and improve the quality of life in the community; and
