1. I (We) agree to pay the sum of **\$250.00** Dollars (cash, credit, or check) for the privilege of connecting to the main line owned by the VILLAGE OF MALONE as part of its water supply system. **THIS FEE MUST BE PAID BEFORE ANY SERVICES CAN BE RENDERED.**
2. I (We) agree to pay all the costs of materials and labor needed to connect to the main line owned by the VILLAGE OF MALONE. **THIS FEE MUST BE PAID UPON COMPLETION OF CONNECTION, BEFORE WATER IS TURNED ON.**
3. I (We) agree to comply will all the Rules and Regulations now made, or to be made, by the VILLAGE OF MALONE relative to water supply. This includes the prescribed quarterly rental charges.

WATER SUPPLY RULES

- A. The Department of Public Works representatives shall have access at all reasonable hours to all parts of the premises to which water is supplied.
- B. The Department of Public Works reserves the right at any time, without notice, to terminate the flow of water in any of its mains in cases of conflagration, to make necessary repairs and extensions, and for such other purposes as become necessary or desirable.

CAUTION: All consumers having boilers within their premises not supplied by tanks or cisterns and depending upon the pressure in the pipes to keep them supplied are hereby cautioned against the danger of collapse. Risk of danger, in all cases, rests exclusively with, and is accepted by, the consumer. In cases of danger the hot water faucet should be opened.

C. The Department of Public Works undertakes only to use all reasonable care and diligence to provide a constant supply of water through its mains to consumers. The VILLAGE OF MALONE shall not be liable to any consumer for damages resulting from the public enemy, the elements, or any accident, misfortune, failure or break in the reservoir of mains of the VILLAGE OF MALONE.

D. All faucets and valves shall be kept in such a state of repair as to ensure that there shall be no waste of water.
