Added Rafter Length

- Added rafter length to new roof because of the way the existing metal building was built had to go from 16ft rafter to 16ft-9" so had to use 20ft rafters because of stock
- Remove existing wall metal to install a 2x6 nailer to hold the metal siding
- > Replace 4ft of rotted top plate
- > Replace 6 rafter ends because of rot
- > Remove existing 4 feet of roof boarding at the eves because of shingles melted into the ice and water barrier; shingles couldn't be removed
- > Re-nail existing roof boarding
- > Install proper vents for air flow into the attic
- > Clean up and haul to landfill

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The Village Board of Trustees hereby authorizes Change Order #2 for the Warming Hut Roof Replacement Project in the amount of \$3,720.02.
