TREASURER REPORT: The Village needs wither an additional phone or conference speaker unit to use when hosting Zoom meetings. Poly Com is \$46/month or a \$657 flat fee plus a monthly service charge of \$10.50. This unit is compatible with the Westelcom system the Village already has in place. The Board discussed looking into the costs of a larger, external microphone for the computer being used to host the Zoom meetings.

Hyde-Stone Mechanical came to perform their annual inspection on the Village air conditioning unit. It has been determined that the second story unit is not working, and the estimate to trouble shoot the issue is \$430.00. Trustees Bonner and Langdon will assess the unit on the second floor and bring a recommendation to the full board.

There are three outstanding Water Bills that have had a huge increase in billing due to the installation of the new water meter and the ability to read the old meter versus the new meter.

The Malone Central School District's water bill is \$165,082.21 and 77 Catherine Street's water bill is \$174,648.66 and 14923 St Rt 30N's water bill is \$4,913.22. This discussion was TABLED until more information about the usage and possible leakages could be gathered and assessed.

DPW: Report as of July 12, 2021:

- > All manhole repairs have been completed
- > All DI repairs have been completed
- > Storm Drains on Elm Street have been uncovered
- > Repaired the DI line in Elm Street that was collapsed
- > Sidewalk replacement list is now underway and will begin pouring this week
- > Paving has been put on hold until August (Availability of Town)

POLICE: Training has been going on and will continue throughout the Summer, including Defensive Techniques, Mental Health De-escalation, and Diversity training. Looking at the Q-Hit Pilot Program; cost to the Village would be \$2,000 annually. Station is being stained, and the conduit near the corner of the station needs to be drained.

CODE: Violation and Building Permit reports submitted and reviewed.

> Application for Building Change of Occupancy – 438 East Main Street

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Paula Coryea asked why 56 Park Street, an apartment house with seven units, is only paying for three sewers, 65 Park, an apartment house of three units, is only paying for two sewers, and why 100 Elm, an apartment house of six apartments, is only paying for four sewers. Charges should be fair across the board and are they going to be back billed for the quarters they were not charged for an accurate number of sewer rents?

The Code Enforcement officer will assess those properties in question. Those found to have more units than sewer rents being paid will be adjusted accordingly.
