After hour, post-accident testing will be billed at \$120 per hour with a minimum of a two-hour charge and 56.5 cents per mile for mileage charge;

**NOW THEREOFRE BE IT RESOLVED:** The Village Board of Trustees authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contractual agreement for a one-year period with Mountain Medical, from January 1, 2021 – December 31, 2021.
