### **VILLAGE OF MALONE RESOLUTION NO. 102-2024**

#### **AUTHORIZATION FOR MAYOR TO SIGN AGREEMENT WITH NEW LIFE ELECTRIC FOR CONNECTION OF THREE STREETLIGHTS ON MAIN STREET BETWEEN ACADEMY STREET AND HARISON PLACE**

**WHEREAS**, the Harison Place Project forced the removal of three Village owned streetlights during the construction phase of the project; and

**WHEREAS**, construction of the Harison Place Project has been completed and the Village has purchased three new streetlights for that section of Main Street that have been pre-assembled by a certified electrician; and

**WHEREAS**, quotes were solicited for the connection of the wired Streetlights to the conduit at the street level;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Village Board of Trustees does hereby authorize the mayor to sign an agreement with New Life Electric at the proposed cost of \$3,628.00 for the connection of three streetlights to the conduit connection that have been placed on Main Street between Academy Street and Harison Place.


